

Vincent Pimpinella, one of the region's highly accomplished soccer coaches, has actively guided competitive soccer teams since 1998. In addition to coaching, he played youth soccer in Rochester, NY and at Alfred University in NY.

Pimpinella has completed multiple levels of coaching education including national licenses through PA West, C-license and National Youth License with US Soccer and goalkeeper coaching with United Soccer Coaches.

He is no stranger to player and club development. In 2002, he established Loyalhanna United Soccer Club as a PA West community club with their own four field complex in Latrobe, PA. In addition to community club involvement, Pimpinella coached several PA West classic clubs and high schools throughout his career. Most notably during the 2007-2016 fall seasons, when he was the Head Girls Varsity Soccer Coach at Greater Latrobe High School. During his time there, the team became a regular presence in the postseason after a 20-year absence.

Currently his role is the development of the first girls' athletic team at The Kiski School as it transitions from a boy's boarding school to a co-ed institution. In the second season of the program, the girls earned a seed in the Pennsylvania Independent Schools Athletic Association State championship. Not only are players developing soccer skills, but Coach Pimpinella teaches character, tenacity, sportsmanship, leadership and responsibility along the way.

Pimpinella has been a PA West staff coach with ODP since 2021 working with both the boys' and girls' programs. He has mentored many players which were selected to the Region 1 and National ODP camps.
